

PATRIOTS DAY ROAD RACE HISTORY

The Lexington Lions Club Patriots Day Road Race is one of the oldest continuous road races in the United States. It was originally called the "Paul Revere Marathon". During the inaugural running in 1914 there were 10 contestants. The original trophy and the 1st place finisher are shown to the right. Below is a list of the first place finishers from 1914 to 2012.
