The committee will judge the candidates against the following criteria:

1. **Must be a current resident of Lexington.**
2. **Must not be a current major elected office holder.**
3. **Must not have won the award previously - The list of previous winners is listed in the Minuteman Newspaper during March and at the Lions web site www.lexingtonlions.org.**
4. **Of the candidates that have met the above qualifications, the committee will select the person who, in their opinion, meets the following criteria based only on the submitted application and supporting material;**
 - **Has demonstrated a dedication to the principles of outstanding leadership.**
 - **Has advanced the American way of life in Lexington by giving unselfishly of his or her time and talents over the years, beyond the normal bounds of his or her normal occupation.**
5. **The award is given without regard to sex, race, or religious affiliation.**
